Operations Department Employee Job Description

Job Responsibilities

- Assists in carpentry layout work, patches streets; digs holes; lays asphalt or milling; pours cement; cuts weeds; builds and repair fences; lays gutters and sidewalks.
- 2 Operate specialized equipment such as dump trucks, sanders, front end loaders, garbage boom truck, tractors and bush hogs, and side boom cutters.
- Hauls milling, sand, gravel, lime and gravel from place of purchase to work sites.
- 4 Responsible for preventative maintenance for flood control. Cleaning and reshaping ditches.
- 5 Check vehicles and equipment to insure proper and safe operations; perform routine maintenance and emergency repairs; reports mechanical problems to supervisor.
- 6 Repairs plumbing in restrooms, drinking fountains, and leaky valves.
- 7 Maintain City landscapes; plants and maintains plants and small trees.
- 8 Pick up trash. Household and limb debris.
- 9 Mows, trims, edges, and waters lawns. Cuts and cleans up uncontrolled weeds.
- 10 Installs, maintains, and repairs recreation equipment.
- Responds to and repairs all City property as needed.
- Repair storm drains and clean ditches as needed to control the flooding of streets and highways.
- 13 Remove nuisance animals and deceased animals as needed.
- May be required to perform various other duties as assigned by Operations Department.

Physical Requirements: Must be physically fit to stand, walk, sit, crouch, climb, and kneel on a regular basis; must be able to regularly lift or move up to 25 pounds and frequently lift or move up to 100 pounds.

Working Conditions:

- Indoor/Outdoor work environment
- Seasonal heat and cold, temperature changes and adverse weather conditions
- Exposure to fumes, dust, odors, pollen, etc.
- Emergency call-out when needed

Minimum Qualifications:

- Preferred experience in street maintenance
- Skilled in lawncare and/or landscaping

- Ability to operate such equipment as bulldozers, backhoe, lawn mowers, edgers, weed eaters, etc.
- Possess a high school diploma or GED
- Possess a current and valid driver's license
- Must be insurable
- Pass a pre-employment background check and an initial drug screen

Salary will be assigned according to years of experience and grade on the Florala Compensation Plan for New Hires.
